## Curriculum Areas

**RE** – Beginning with the Church.

**English** – Narratives, Poetry, Instructions and Recounts.

**Maths** –Autumn term covers a wide range of maths areas including: Problem solving, counting, addition and subtraction, doubling, shapes and money.

**Science** – Everyday materials.

**ICT** – E-Safety and basic computing skills

**Geography/History** – How to read and use a map and look at changes within living memory.

## Important General Notices/Info

**PE Kit** – All classes do PE on a Tuesday morning and PE kits will go home every half term. Earrings are to be removed at home before school on Tuesday. If not removed children will have to observe PE. This is a National Curriculum subject and all children have to participate.

**Reading** – Children should enjoy reading every evening. Please encourage/listen as much as possible at home. It is your child's responsibility to return their book every Monday to be changed.

**Uniform** – Please remember correct uniform at all times, especially hats to be worn to and from school. Please help your child to be able to independently do up their top button, tie and laces.

**NAMES** – **Please put your child's name on their uniform, PE kit, footwear, lunchbox, and all appropriate items to avoid items being lost.**

**Homework** – All encouragement and support welcomed at home. Although please always aim for your child to work independently to increasing their learning.

**Behaviour** – Parental support for your child's good behaviour towards all adults is required and appreciated. We promote independent learning in Year 1 and expect children to take responsibility for their belongings, themselves and their learning.

**Illness** – **If children have experienced vomiting or diarrhoea, you must inform the school, and please note that children are not permitted back to school until 48hrs after the last time they vomited or had diarrhoea.**
