

Year 1 – Curriculum and General Information – Spring Term 2018

Happy New Year! Well done to all Year 1 for all of their hard work far. Below is some helpful information that we hope you will find useful about the Spring Term.



Curriculum Areas

RE – Jesus at Prayer. We will be focusing on The story of Moses and Passover.

English – Narratives, Poetry, Letter writing and Recounts. We will continue to focus on spelling, grammar and punctuation as well as handwriting and using the correct letter formation.

Maths – Spring term covers a wide range of maths areas including:

Word problems involving addition and subtraction, money, multiplication, division, and problem solving.

Science – the human body learning to identify, name and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense. We will also continue to look at the seasons.

ICT – programming and coding, E-Safety

Geography/History – locational knowledge.

Art – design and make a print influenced by Inuit art.

PE – dance, agility, co-ordination and balance.

Music – Taught by Mr Brown. Year 1 Exploring rhythm and pulse, then exploring pitch.

Important General Notices/Info

PE Kit – All classes do PE on a Tuesday morning and PE kits will go home every half term. Earrings are to be removed at home before school on Tuesday. If not removed, children will have to observe PE. This is a National Curriculum subject and all children have to participate.

Reading – Children should enjoy reading every evening. Please encourage/listen as much as possible at home. It is your child's responsibility to return their book every Monday to be changed.

- what do you predict this story to be about?
- who is the author and what is the title?
- what did the character just do and why do you think that?
- what do you think the character is like?
- what do you think will happen next?
- can you retell the story to me?
- where did the story take place?
